## EYNSFORD CONCERT BAND

Eynsford Concert Band was formed in 1972 as a local community band. From humble beginnings, featuring a handful of keen musicians eager to share their talents, the band has blossomed into an enthusiastic and highly motivated fraternity entertaining audiences world-wide including Malta, Canada, Cyprus, Austria, Spain, Germany, Southern Ireland and nearer to home the Royal Albert Hall with the London Philharmonic Orchestra and several concerts at the Queen Elizabeth on the South Bank. The band's diverse variety of inspired music encompassing both the popular and classical, coupled with sheer enthusiasm has enabled them to produce a first class CD entitled "By the Ford", copies of which are available during the interval. The band itself is a registered charity and is constantly in need of further funding, but when we heard that the local St John Ambulance were in need of support we felt that this concert would be an ideal opportunity to raise money for their appeal. Tonight's performance would not have been possible without the support and guidance from the Sevenoaks Rotary Club. We hope you enjoy tonight's performance and we thank you for supporting this worthy cause.

## THE ROTARY CLUB OF SEVENOAKS

The Rotary Club was established and chartered 64 years ago with the principal object of "Service above Self". They are one of the oldest Service Clubs in the district giving support to charitable organisations and the local community.

## ST JOHN AMBULANCE SEVENOAKS

The local division of the St John Ambulance service is embedded in Sevenoaks history. They are over 75 years old and served in a nursing capacity during the Second World War. The local division has been located on the same site for its entire life. In the last 3 years it has been through a period of revitalisation and is currently being adopted and assisted by the Sevenoaks Rotary Club. In the last 3 years the division has shown the most rapid growth of any division in Kent by doubling its duties and community projects. It has fund raised for and purchased a new ambulance, and is fund raising for improvements to its headquarters.

## COLIN PALMER - CONDUCTOR

Colin has been musical director of various local amateur dramatic societies for the last ten years. He has also been a member of the Eynsford Concert Band's trumpet section for the last sixteen years. During the summer Colin can be seen conducting many of the bands outdoor concerts which he enjoys greatly. Colin studied trumpet under Ray Allen, and was a product of the Bromley Youth Music Centre.

## BOB OGLE - COMPERE

Our Compere tonight is Bob Ogle, a member of Sevenoaks Rotary Club and former editor of the Sevenoaks Chronicle who now writes a weekly "nostalgic" column for the newspaper. Bob was born in Sevenoaks and is an author of more than a dozen books including In The Wake of The Hurricane which went into the top ten best-seller list and stayed there for seven months. He has also written Kent at War, Biggin on the Bump, Doodlebugs and Rockets, The Kent Weather Book and is currently working on the second volume of his county history series Kent - A Chronicle of the Century. Bob has travelled extensively in pursuit of information and photographs and is in great demand as a speaker to clubs all over the south east. He also has a regular weekly broadcasting spot on Radio Kent.

## JOHN HUTCHINS - TRUMPET

John Hutchins began playing the trumpet at the age of eight at a local Music School in Essex. He began his music career in HM Irish Guards Band where he travelled extensively, during this time he studied privately with one of the country's leading trumpet players, George Reynolds. In 1996 he gained a scholarship to study musical performance with James Watson and John Wallace at the Royal Academy of Music. John also plays the Natural and Slide Trumpet under the direction of Ian Wilson and Crispin Steele-Perkins. Last year John was privileged to be invited to participate in an International trumpet Seminar at Lake Placid USA with a faculty consisting of John Wallace, Ed Carroll, James Thompson, Bob Brookmeyer, and Tom Steven's. John is no stranger to the Eynsford Concert Band. The band is pleased to welcome John back in this a very demanding performance of the Arutunian Trumpet Concerto.

## KAREN JONES - FLUTE

Karen has rapidly become one of the most sought after flute players of her generation. She first came to public attention in 1982 when she won the woodwind section of the BBC TV Young Musician of The Year. The following year she won a scholarship to study at the Guild Hall School of Music with Peter Lloyd. A number of awards enabled her to continue her studies in Vienna and New York. In 1985 she won the gold medal of the Shell LSO Scholarship which led to Concerto performances with Sir Neville Marriner at the Queen Elizabeth Hall, with Andrew Litton at the Royal Festival Hall and with the Philharmonia, Hall'e, Ulster and Wren Orchestras. She has made various solo recordings including a double album of virtuoso flute music. Karen was principal flute of the Bournemouth Symphony Orchestra from 1990 to 1995 and now plays as guest principal with all the countries leading orchestras. To accompany Karen tonight we are pleased to welcome David Grubb on Piano.
