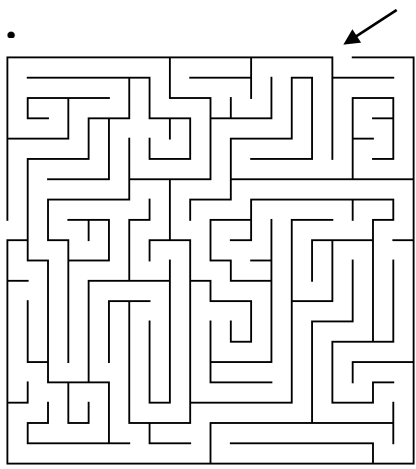

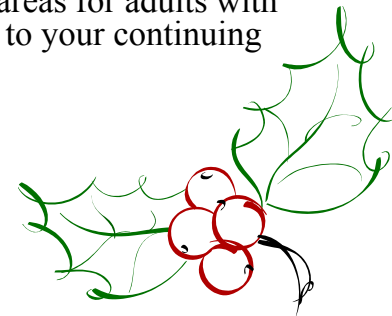
This year, the band has been raising money for the Bexley branch of The Alzheimer's Society, in memory of my father, who died from this terrible disease in 2005. It is impossible to put into words the effect this illness has, not only on the patient, but also on their immediate family, and this is where the work of the charity is invaluable.

They run support groups where patients and their carers can go for a chat with people in the same position, as well as to receive practical advice on coping, both emotionally and financially with the situation. They also operate respite facilities, to give the families a break and to allow them to recharge their batteries, safe in the knowledge that their loved one is receiving the best possible care.

The money we have raised this year will make an enormous difference to the services that the Bexley branch will be able to offer in the coming year, and I would like to say a massive thank you for your kind generosity.

Next year, the band will be raising money for a charity called Spadework, a local independent training organisation, which undertakes tuition in a number of subject areas for adults with learning disabilities, and we look forward to your continuing support for our efforts.
