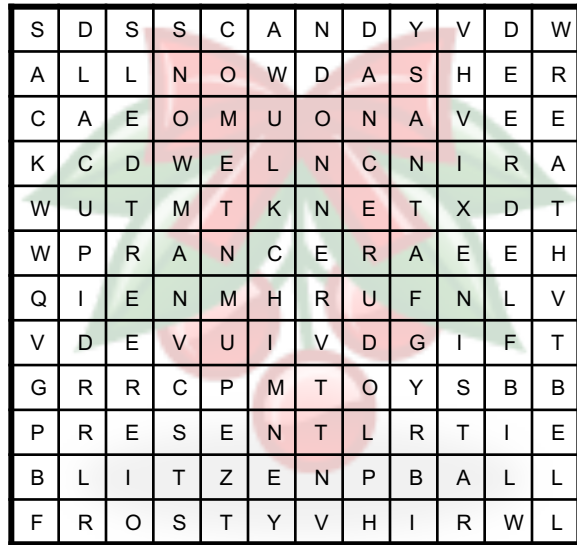

Each of these composers has contributed towards advancing this medium, one of the most popular amongst amateur musical groups in the United Kingdom, in the process giving countless musicians the chance to perform original and inspiring music.

The CD includes the world's first recording of Heritage Suite (What Hope Saw) - our specially commissioned piece by Nigel Clarke. The other works featured are 'Albion Heritage' by Philip Sparke; 'Paris Sketches' by Martin Ellerby; 'Thames Journey' by Nigel Hess and 'Yiddish Dances' by Adam Gorb.
